

The Brazos County 4-H Adult Leaders would like to recognize our outstanding senior age division youth who qualify for a National 4-H Contest and/or National 4-H Trip. We readily understand and appreciate the time, effort, and hard work it takes to advance to the national level. Each of you make us proud! Thank you for representing the Brazos County 4-H Program! With that being said, The Brazos County 4-H Adult Leaders organization has voted to increase the amount given to senior age division 4-H members attending a qualified National 4-H Trip or qualified National 4-H Contest to \$1,000 per trip. The 4-H member must have participated in at least one fundraiser for the Brazos County 4-H Adult Leaders. The fundraisers include selling pecan and peanuts in the fall or baking a cake/cookie/pie/cobbler for the 4-H cake show in the summer. Eligibility will be verified with the Brazos County Extension Office. The 4-H member is required to attend the adult leaders meeting after their trip or contest to only describe the trip and what they learned. 

Books close at 7:00 AM on Saturday, September 10, 2022. No exceptions. Steer and heifer judging begins at 9 AM on Saturday, September 10, 2022.

- The show is open to all Texas 4H and FFA members with Junior Beef projects. No out of state entries.
- Entries are only allowed online at <a href="https://washtxfps.fairwire.com">https://washtxfps.fairwire.com</a>. Entries and payments are due by midnight on September 1, 2022.
   Late entries are accepted until books close at \$120 per head (Both rings included in this fee)!
  - Entries are non-refundable.
  - Entry fee is \$100 per head, which allows entry in both rings. You may not enter only one ring.
    - · No pre-stalling is allowed. No trim chutes or generators are allowed in the barns.
      - Cattle will be stalled on sand. No shavings are allowed.
      - Three head or less will show as one class in both steer and heifer divisions.
        - No health papers are required.
- Cattle are released at the conclusion of their breed. No cattle can remain on the fairgrounds Saturday
  night.
  - A champion showman will be selected in each division for steers and heifers in Ring B only.
