Important Reminder from Brazos County Adult Leaders New for 2022-2023:

The Brazos County 4-H Adult Leaders would like to recognize our outstanding senior age division youth who qualify for a National 4-H Contest and/or National 4-H Trip. We readily understand and appreciate the time, effort, and hard work it takes to advance to the national level. Each of you make us proud! Thank you for representing the Brazos County 4-H Program! With that being said, The Brazos County 4-H Adult Leaders organization has voted to increase the amount given to senior age division 4-H members attending a qualified National 4-H Trip or qualified National 4-H Contest to \$1,000 per trip. The 4-H member must have participated in at least one fundraiser for the Brazos County 4-H Adult Leaders. The fundraisers include selling pecan and peanuts in the fall or baking a cake/cookie/pie/cobbler for the 4-H cake show in the summer. Eligibility will be verified with the Brazos County Extension Office. The 4-H member is required to attend the adult leaders meeting after their trip or contest to only describe the trip and what they learned. TEXAS 4-H OPPORTUNITY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

ABOUT:

The Texas 4-H Foundation Opportunity Scholarship Program awards academic scholarships each year to applicants based on their academic record, 4-H experience, and financial need. Thanks to our generous donors, we are able to award scholarships to 4-H members though Baccalaureate, Collegiate, Courageous Heart and Technical Scholarships. The goal of the scholarship program is to provide scholarship opportunities for 4-H members to attend a Texas college or university, to pursue a broad range of academic majors. Texas 4-H Youth Development has a proud history of providing young people with opportunities in leadership, citizenship, community service, and personal growth. The Texas 4-H Foundation Opportunity Scholarship Program began in 1959 with a \$1,000 scholarship. Since that time, our scholarship program has experienced tremendous growth, currently awarding over 220 scholarships totaling more than \$2.7 million annually.

TYPES OF SCHOLARSHIPS:

Baccalaureate:

Awarded to students who wish to pursue a Bachelor of Science or Bachelor of Arts degree from an accredited Texas College or University.

Collegiate:

Designated for former Texas 4-H members who have been graduated from high school for at least one year, at time of awarding, and have completed a minimum of 30 hours of college credit at a grade point average of at least a 2.7.

Courageous Heart:

Awarded to Texas 4-H members that are pursuing either a Baccalaureate or Technical degree and have had to overcome an extreme obstacle while staying active in both 4-H and school.

Technical:

Awarded to students who wish to pursue technical certification in a recognized and approved major or course of study.

\$30 fee per shooter for registered 4-H Connect members (lunch included with shooter's fee)
\$35 fee for adult shooters who are coaches, parents, and/or guardians of 4-H members

*Additional lunches available for spectators, \$5 each (please preorder)

Outdoor 30 target 3-D course; 1 arrow at varying yardages for all ages (per 4-H rules)

Open to the first 100 shooters!

4-H rules apply, scoring as follows: 12 points for an "inner circle" or "X" ring, 10 points for a hit in the inner "heart" area, 5 points for a hit in the "outer" ring, any other shot hitting the animal = "H" but scored as a zero (0). Bounce-outs must be mutually agreed upon with your group or it is considered a miss.

Please mark your arrows for identification purposes. All shooters and spectators are **required** to wear pants and closed toed shoes. This range takes place in a wooded area; there is poison ivy, poison oak, bugs, snakes, so please dress accordingly. Some additional suggestions; sunscreen, insect repellent, hat or cap and the possible need for water boots.

NO RANGE FINDERS; however, binoculars are allowed!

<u>BUCKLES</u> will be given for 1st place and banners will be given for 2nd and 3rd place in each division! Adults will be given buckle for 1st and banners for 2nd and 3rd place (all disciplines under ONE division for adults this year).
