

- Entries are only allowed online at https://washtxfps.fairwire.com. Entries and payments are due by midnight on September 1, 2022. Late entries are accepted until books close at \$120 per head (Both rings included in this fee)!
 - Entries are non-refundable.
 - Entry fee is \$100 per head, which allows entry in both rings. You may not enter only one ring.
 - No pre-stalling is allowed. No trim chutes or generators are allowed in the barns.
 - Cattle will be stalled on sand. No shavings are allowed.
 - Three head or less will show as one class in both steer and heifer divisions.
 - No health papers are required.
- Cattle are released at the conclusion of their breed. No cattle can remain on the fairgrounds Saturday
 - night.
 A champion showman will be selected in each division for steers and heifers in Ring B only.





This is a 4-H event; therefore, all entrants must be members of Texas 4-H for the current year.

Payment

Payment can be submitted on www.iclays.com. Payment includes registration & lunch for shooter.

Refund Policy

Refunds, minus a \$25.00 registration fee will be made to any shooter who cancels between September 1 -September 16, 2022. NO refunds will be made for cancellations or no-shows after September 16, 2022. All refund requests must be received in writing by email. All refunds will be processed and granted after the tournament is complete. If event is cancelled due to COVID-19, all entry fees will be refunded.

Parents/Coach/Siblings on Field

First, and foremost, all spectators including, but not limited to parents and coaches, must have protective eyewear and earwear. If this is not present on each observer, you will be asked by a marshal to leave the course. No coaching will be allowed while the youth shooter is on the field or in the cage during events. For safety reasons, parents will not be allowed on the Whiz-bang Platform/Field.

Protest Procedure

Protests should be initiated immediately to the field referee and can only be initiated by the shooter. No protest will be accepted from parents and/or coaches.

Tie Breakers

Any ties for places 1-5 will be settled by a shoot-off and will be announced via Remind.

Code of Conduct

The current 4-H Code of Conduct will be enforced both on and off the field during the event. Shooters, volunteers, family members or observers may be expelled for the event, match, or grounds for failure to comply. Shoot management reserves the right to refuse future registration for any shooter who does not comply with the current 4-H Code of Conduct.

Shooting Agreement and Waiver of Liability

All participants must fill out and return the Shooting Agreement and Waiver of Liability form and turn in during Shootout Check-in. Each shooter (adult and youth) will need to sign the attached waiver and attend the morning Safety Meeting at 8:30.

ATV/Golf Carts


