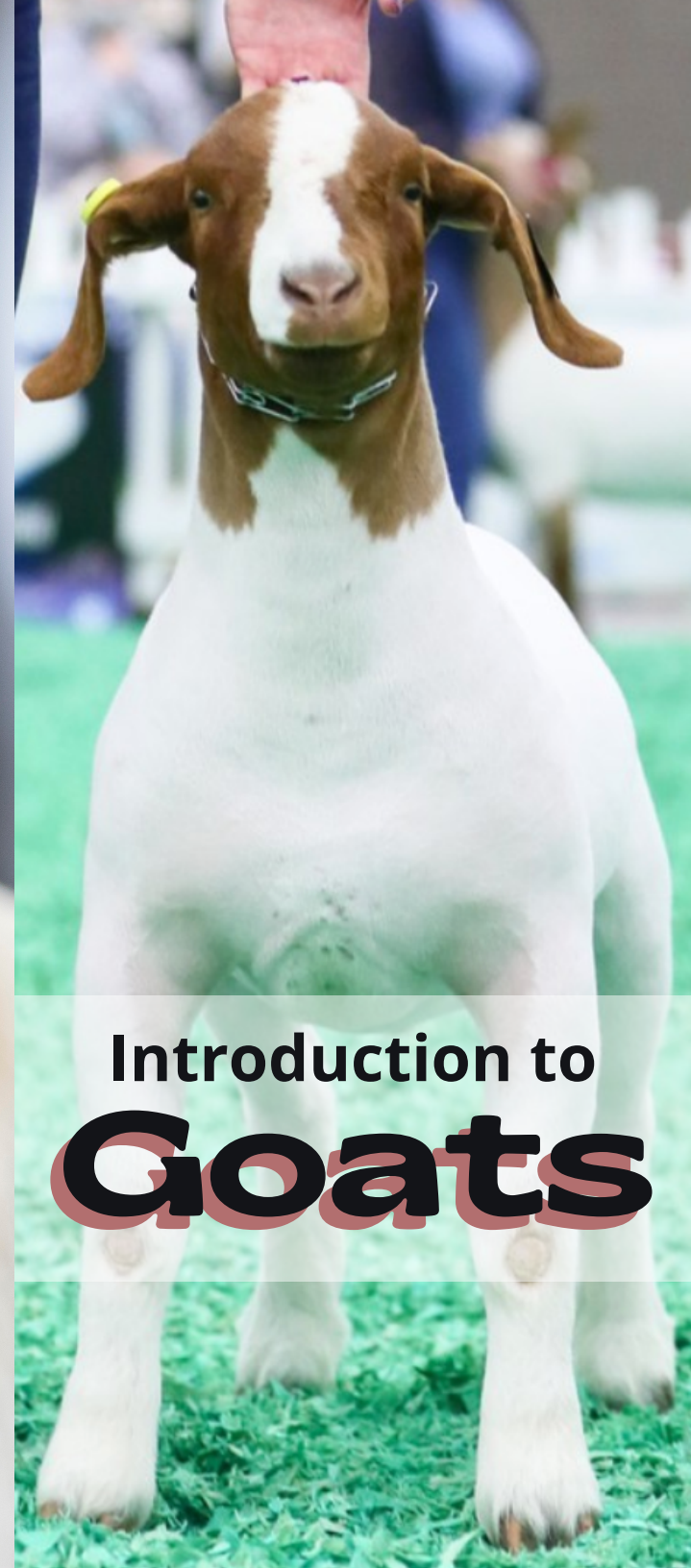

# Introduction to Goats



## **Facilities**

- Pens should be big enough to allow the goats to move around comfortably.
- The area should be well ventilated & have a covered area where they can go to eat & escape the elements.
- Good storage for feed & supplies with access to water & electricity
- An area designed for exercising your goat is ideal (track, treadmill, walker, etc).
- Goats are curious by nature; try to avoid items they can accidentally injure themselves on.

## **Raising Show Goats**

### **Project Duration-**

- Market goat projects last about 6 months.

### **Time Commitments-**

- Exhibitors should plan to spend around 1-2 hours daily with their goats feeding them, practicing their showmanship, & exercising goat(s).
- Additional time should be set aside to halter break & become familiar with the animal initially.
- Allow 1-2 additional hours a few days prior to a show for shearing & preparation.

## **Basic Supplies**

- Rope halters
- Show collar or chain
- Feed & water troughs
- Access to a trailer or lamb cage for travel, clippers, & a blower
- Comb for leg hair
- blankets & muzzles

### **Consider**

- What is your target show?
  - county-level
  - major show
- Project timeline
- Conflicting activities & responsibilities.
- Cost (est. \$1,500 total)
- Some goats don't enjoy being alone, so you may have to get a companion.
