Highlights of major projects, life skills learned, or special notes that the member would like to share with the audience should be included. Brazos 4-H Adult Leaders Association Scholarships

The Brazos 4-H Adult Leaders Association will give 6 (six) \$3000 scholarships to deserving Brazos County 4-H members. Three of the Scholarships will be given in memory of Brazos County 4-H members who were very active members of the Brazos County 4-H program for manyyears:

The Alisa Hickerson Memorial Scholarship,

The Katie Young Memorial Scholarship,

The David Plagens Memorial Scholarship and

The Gregorio G. Balderas, Sr. Scholarship Award Established 2022.

The purpose of each scholarship is to recognize 4-H members who have been active in the Brazos County 4-H program for at least three years. Selection is based on 4-H experience, which includes 4-H Projects, 4-H leadership, 4-H Achievements, Community Service and Non 4-H Activities.

Scholarships will be paid out in one lump sum payment of \$3000. It will be paid the spring semester after the scholarship recipients freshman year. Scholarship winners must take a minimum of 12 hours for their fall semester with proof of their registration and fee statement provided to the Brazos County Adult Leaders. Proof should be sent to the Brazos County Extension Office. Once this is received, the Brazos Adult Leaders Association Treasurer will forward your scholarship disbursement. The recipient is required to make a grade point average of 2.0 or above based on a 4.0 system. It is the recipient's responsibility to provide the required information to the Brazos County 4-H Adult Leaders Association to receive the scholarship. Only graduating seniors are eligible for the scholarship.

Each applicant should send a:

- Completed Brazos Adult Leaders Association Scholarship form.
- Biography
- Narrative
- Current copy of his/her high school transcript to the Brazos County Extension Office by the application deadline date.
- Completed 2023-2024 Recordbook does not need to be judged.

BRAZOS COUNTY 4-H WALLACE KIMBROUGH SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Established 1983

WALLACE M. KIMBROUGH 1913-1958

Wallace Kimbrough served as County Agent of Brazos County from 1945 until 1958. Although crippled by polio since high school, and diabetic, he worked tirelessly with county farmers, ranchers, and 4-H members. Under his leadership, Brazos County Judging Teams won numerous state championships, second and third place finishes, and numerous district championships. Livestock and poultry projects of 4-H members consistently did well in the major livestock shows of Texas.

He was awarded the Distinguished Service Awards by the National County Agricultural Agents Association in 1955. His leadership and genuine concern for others was an inspiration to many 4-H members that are now successful business and professional men.

Charter Donors of this award were all members of State Championship Judging Teams coached by Wallace Kimbrough.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD INFORMATION

4H Alumni will provide scholarships of not less than \$500.00 to a 4-H member in Brazos County to attend Texas A&M. The candidate must be a May 2024 High School Graduate and must be enrolled at Texas A&M in the Fall of 2024. Selection of the Scholarship will be based on need, scholarship, leadership, citizenship and participation in activities including 4-H judging teams, judging events and competition.

Brazos Extension Horse Committee Scholarship Application

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

Applications are furnished by the Brazos Extension Horse Committee. They should be completed in full and returned **no later than 5:00PM, Thursday, June 20, 2024** to the Brazos County Office of the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service, 4153 County Park Court, Bryan TX 77802. Applicants will be confined to those who have been either accepted or are enrolled in a college, university or trade school. These scholarships are not limited to a specific or restricted major.

The number of scholarships and the amounts of individual scholarships will be based on applicants' merit and availability of funds. A maximum of \$4,000 will be awarded annually.

Although financial need is not a criterion of this scholarship, we will seriously consider a well-documented financial need with an application.

Applicant must include the following:

Typed or handwritten scholarship application with signature of the applicant.

Signature, on the application, of the county agent from the applicant's home county.

Current copy of high school transcript and if appropriate, a post high school transcript.

A typed narrative, not to exceed two pages, double spaced. Font should not be smaller than 10 point. In this narrative, the applicant may supply any information which he/she feels is pertinent to the application receiving proper consideration.

The candidate must be either accepted in or enrolled in a full-time training or educational program as a full-time student. Scholarship winners must take a minimum of 14 hours for the 2024 fall semester. If the applicant is awarded a scholarship, he/she must provide proof of registration and payment to the BEHC

before the recipient's scholarship check is mailed.

This scholarship is awarded to those applicants who reside in the Brazos Valley Council of Governments, i.e. Brazos, Burleson, Grimes, Leon, Madison, Robertson, and Washington counties in Texas. However, those persons temporarily residing outside of this region for purposes of pursuing a post high school education are not excluded from this scholarship opportunity.

This scholarship is tendered by the Brazos Extension Horse Committee. The application should describe a high level of scholarship as well as a demonstrated interest in equines, equine activities or equine organizations over multiple years.

The applicant may attach any written recommendation from any person occupying an adult position of leadership who has knowledge of the applicant's participation in equine activities.

Applicants who list participation in a 4-H Program must have a signature of the County Extension Agent (CEA) in the section reserved for that certification.
